#### **Compost**

## Residential Recycling

All material must be clean and dry with lids removed.

#### Glass:

- Any color glass is acceptable.
- Labels do not need to be removed.
- Do not recycle drinking glasses, windows, mirrors, Pyrex, or crystal.

#### Tin Cans:

- Remove the labels.
- Empty aerosol cans go in the garbage.

#### #1, #2, #5 Plastics:

- Any empty plastics from cooking oil, motor oil, antifreeze, or a hazardous material should be placed in the garbage.
- All other numbers of plastics go in the garbage.

#### Plastic bags and film (#4):

 Can be taken to your local grocery store or the landfill office.

#### Paper Products:

 All of the newspaper, junk mail and used paper (any color).

#### Cardboard:

- Break down corrugated cardboard and paperboard boxes like cereal boxes.
- Any wax coated or soiled cardboard should be put in the garbage Ex. Pizza boxes.

Recycling has been mandatory since 1995 in the Marshall County Landfill Service Area by the ordinance of all towns and in the countryside.



Charges for recycling and solid waste services are available by contacting the independent haulers.
